

- NH QSO Party
 - September 20-21
 - Sponsored by Port City Amateur Radio Club
 - Need Every Member on the air make your contribution and have fun!
 - Points awarded by number of contacts, number of counties, states, provinces and DX
 - Last year, 71 Award Certificates
 - Past years not all 10 NH counties activated
 - Previous years feedback expresses some disappointment with number of NH stations participating
 - New this year
 - New categories, including 'Portable and Mobile' more opportunity for Awards
 - Emphasis on activating counties
 - Notification to all NH Clubs Get on the Air
 - Easy to submit log, easy to manage

Facilitating POTA And All-County Activation

- Club goal this year is to have operators in all 10 NH counties
- 2/3 Club Radio-in-a-Box units available power, antennas required
- Two-person teams, ideally pairing new POTA operators with veterans; CW, SSB & digital capable; helping each other fill equipment gaps
- NH county hunters combined with POTA hunters should make activating parks easier and boost POTA QSO stats
- Planning guideline for operators available


PCARC Deployment Plan

Rules Update

- Out-of-state stations multipliers expanded to include 10 counties on all 5 bands for a total of 50: promote greater interest across the range of available bands
- In-State stations only 10 counties, states, provinces, 10 DX total
- New operating categories: portable and mobile. Created to attract POTA operators to participate in the contest and explore new operating sites

- Note: N1MM version 1.01.10896 or later

Post-Event Log Processing

- Previous years required much manual processing
 - Participants email Cabrillo file to K1RX.
 - Mr and Mrs K1RX manually enter callsign, category, and score into spreadsheet
 - K1RX emails to N1RP
 - N1RP adds names, email addresses, and states
 - Sorted by category, state, score
 - Awards determined
 - Award Certificates emailed to winners
- New for 2025
 - Online log submission on w1wqm.org
 - Program to extract data from Cabrillo file and enter into spreadsheet
 - Goal is to reduce ~40 hours of manual effort
 - Faster Results posted on the web site
